-Warren Horris presented "A Proposal for a Revision of the By-Laws of the Austin G&S Society: At its December meeting, the Executive Board voted to recomment to the mon bership that the Annual Meeting should take place in January rather than in September as previously required by the By Laws. Therefore, I propose the following amendments:
1. Section 4. Article A to atrike the word "September" and put the

word "January" in Ita place.

2. Section 9. Article A to strike the words "September 1 to August 31"

and put the words "January I to December 31" in their places.
3. Section 9, Article E to strike the word "July" andput the word

"November" in its place."
