

Meeting: February 6, 7.30 Kleberg Hall, St. George's 4301 N. IH35. Fred's birth day - bring <sup>food & beverages (please)</sup> As those of you know who attended the last meeting, the sing-through of the Mikado was a great success. I think we all had a lot of fun and hopefully, will do more sing-throughs in the future. We voted on the shows that we wanted to sing next (with a view to doing one of them in November). Results: Patience 11, Iolanthe 9, Gondoliers 7, Yeomen 6, Illa 4, Utopia 1, Ruddigore 1. So in March we will sing through Patience, and in April, Iolanthe.

James McGrew, President of the Zachary Scott Board of Directors was present, and he gave us some information about the September production of The Mikado. This will be put on at the Paramount Theatre, and plans are afoot to get the city to sponsor using Symphony members in the orchestra, directed by Endo. Sounds quite exciting. The shows will be September 15, 16 and 17 with auditions held early - possibly in the spring, and then rehearsals starting during the summer. Steve Wyman will direct the show, which will be done "traditionally".

Warren Morris presented "A Proposal for a Revision of the By-Laws of the Austin G&S Society: At its December meeting, the Executive Board voted to recommend to the membership that the Annual Meeting should take place in January rather than in September as previously required by the By-Laws. Therefore, I propose the following amendments:

1. Section 4, Article A to strike the word "September" and put the word "January" in its place.
2. Section 9, Article A to strike the words "September 1 to August 31" and put the words "January 1 to December 31" in their places.
3. Section 9, Article E to strike the word "July" and put the word "November" in its place."

For those of you without copies of the bylaws this is simply stating that instead of holding our officers elections in September (which would conflict with our annual show in November as those of us who assumed office in September last year know), we would hold the elections in January, after the performance and all that business is out of the way.

Added to this proposal was that the present officers should remain in office until January 1979.

All of this will be voted on at the February meeting so please if you are at all interested in this, come and vote. Present officers are: President Phil Smith, Production V-Pres. Steve Sansom, Executive V-Pres Bill Buchanan, Treasurer Sue Ricket Caldwell, Publicity Rosemary Russell Vines, Hist-Parl Warren Morris, and Sec Ann Coltman.

I hope that that is all the legalese that is required ...

Sue Ricket Caldwell came up with a Statement of Finances for us from 1 September 1977 to 8 January 1978. Broadly, it states that we started in September with a Balance of \$46.06, spent \$503.81 on the show, made \$1492.03 on the show, and have a balance now of \$1034.28. I have copies of it broken down if you are interested. I also have copies of the bylaws if anyone wants a copy.

As has been long promised, here is the address list. I got a very nice letter from David Dow who drove down from Waco to attend the last meeting. He had paid our dues for membership to the University of Michigan G&S Society which entitles us to GASBAG, a monthly publication. Also to Madison Savoyards, Ltd have us on their mailing list, so we are extending our mailing list too.

David Dow has written to tell us about Baylor's production of Pinafore April 22, 23, 24, 25. He has suggested a party after the show on Sunday - a matinee on the 23rd and has invited us. I need to know how many people to get tickets for - so that he can arrange it.

Lastly, SORCERER CHORUS still owes me costumes and/or money. I especially need the women's costumes that I borrowed from my friends who are rapidly becoming ex friends...
