Before you go to sell ads, choose the business wisely. Be sure to know all the information on the attached advertising contract. Most importantly, know about the show:

- \* Thirteen performances, May 20 through June 5
- \* The total audience will be approximately 2,500 to 3,000 people
- \* Be able to talk briefly about the show's story, music, and dancing (attending the open rehearsal will help)

Calling ahead to make an appointment with the person in charge of advertising will save time.

When you actually go to sell the ad, go at a relatively slow time (mid to late evening for restaurants and bars). Be sure to mention that the business will not only support the arts, the ad will reach hundreds of people who attend the theater. Our shows have all been popular and successful. If you need copies of previous program ads, Zachery Scott Theatre Center (ZSTC) can provide you with extras.

We've already sold ads for the following businesses: Pecan Street Cafe, First Federal Savings, University Co-op Books, and the general bank market.

We should especially contact restaurants, bars, book stores, and realtors. Elota Patton of ZSTC suggested we try the following: The Driskill, The Avenue, Hyde Park Bar & Grill, Kerbey Street Cafe, Hyatt Dessert Bar, Sheraton, Comedy Workshop, Piggy's, Waterloo Ice House, and Maggie Mae's. You can suggest to restaurants that they can offer a free drink coupon with the ad.

Be sure to contact Katharine at 327-2488 before you go out to sell ads. She will be able to give you an updated list of ads we've sold.
